Colorado Coalition for the Homeless' Statement Regarding Unionization Vote by the Housing Support Services Department

DENVER, CO - This evening on Wednesday, January 22nd, staff members from the Housing Support Services Department (HSS) at the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless voted in a National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) supervised election in support of having the Service Employees International Union (SEIU) represent eligible members of that department on the terms and conditions of their employment. The Executive Team is committed to working collaboratively with SEIU and the impacted employees through the next phase of the collective bargaining agreement process, while continuing to provide high-quality housing, healthcare, and supportive services to individuals and families experiencing or at risk of homelessness throughout Colorado.
